

Corsica Development Corporation Meeting Minutes

The Corsica Development Corporation Board met at the Netherlands Reformed School at 6:30 am. Board members present were: Dave Koedam, Keith Sprecher, Trent Van Den Hoek, Scott Vanden Berge, and Jamie Rexwinkel. Representing the City Council was Mayor Dick Brink. Dave Lambert Director of Development for the Regional Development Association was also present.

Dave Koedam gave a tour of the new school and provided coffee and rolls.

- Project Maverick – The Project is moving forward, will have more information as summer progresses.
- Airport Development –Final costs of the building and GA terminal are being put together. The fuel system is near completion. Handling of water usage was discussed.
- Ag Development –Lambert was contacted by Ag Industry Representative from California regarding working together with dairy farmers. Cost and regulations are the reasons they are looking to relocate. They are still seeking properties for dairies with 500 to 5000 cows. There has been interest in the area from producers in a potential dairy project.
- Corsica Animal Health Clinic was presented potential sites for a new building.
- Main Street property – Motion was made by Sprecher to move forward with securing the main street property for development purposes. Koedam seconded, Motion carried.
- Purchase Agreement with Groeneweg Construction has been signed, waiting for Paul and Bank for final closing.
- Project Clipper – A Food Processing Company looking for available property. This is a large project and Lambert will request more information from GOED. After receiving additional information Lambert will determine whether or not to submit an application for the project.
