# Highlights of Council Meeting

June 4, 2018 – New Holland CRC

Here are some items from this month's council meeting.

1. Curt & Harriet Ver Steeg are mowing the church lawn for the summer.
2. Approval was given for the GEMS to use the parsonage front lawn for the overnigher June 19-20.
3. We discussed the procedure to use if anyone wants to contribute to a certain fund for the church; such as the parking lot fund. They may place their contribution in an envelope. Then designate the fund on the envelope and on the check memo. It can then be placed in any offering or given directly to a deacon or church bookkeeper.
4. We reviewed church order articles which authorize assemblies (council, classis, synod) to appoint committees to carry out its work, and which describe how office bearers are delegated to classis and synod.
5. The next scheduled council meeting was set for August 6.
