Especially if you are elderly, are in a weakened physical condition, or have symptoms of a cold or flu. And please try to observe social distancing as best you can. Thank you for your cooperation.

As of July 12, 2020

1. We will return to all our practices for and around worship services, which we did before the COVID-19 restrictions, except for the following:
 - No handshaking – Examples: no greeters, no mutual greeting during the service
 - No passing of plates – Examples: no offerings during morning worship, going forward for communion
2. We will start up second worship services again.

Partaking of Communion

At the communion service, we will go forward to partake of the elements.

1. We will be directed when and how to come forward.
2. We will pick up a piece of bread and eat it immediately. We will then take a cup and drink it immediately, disposing it in a trash container nearby.
