The new church building committee met with the architect recently and decided we have to make a decision on the organ sooner rather than later in order to move forward with designs on the pulpit area. As a committee it is our recommendation to move forward without the organ. We based our decision on several factors: The age of the organ, lack of organists, as well as the costs just to remove, repair, and install it in the new church. The bid for removing and rebuilding along with minor repairs is \$110,000. To reconstruct the keyboard and pedals unit separate from the system is another \$20,000. And if needed, climate-controlled storage would be another \$1000. The council has stated that if money was given specifically for the organ to pay for all expenses, it would be kept. As a congregation our deadline for this decision is March 4.
