**Good morning! Welcome to our Easter Celebration  
It's Resurrection Day!**

For those of you who were not able to be at the Friday night Good Friday service... We were asked the question **Who is Jesus?** And we went on the journey of Jesus from the time Jesus went into the Garden of Gethsemane where the olive presses were, to his arrest, trial crucifixion and to the tomb. Each person on this journey was like those at the triumphal entry on Palm Sunday where many were confused about the true identity and mission of Jesus.

Friday night we were repeatedly asked **Were You There?** Were you there in the garden when Jesus surrendered his will to his father's? Were you there when he was falsely accused and condemned to die? Were you there when he bled and died? Were you there when they took his battered body and place it in the tomb? Jesus made that journey to reveal his love and identity so that you and I could celebrate today, not as spectators of a miracle—but participants in the saving work of the sacrificial lamb on the cross. Because of Jesus death and resurrection, we can celebrate today! We celebrate new life in Jesus as we flower the cross, as we celebrate communion with a risen Jesus, the King of Kings, and Lord of Lords. There is no longer any question about who Jesus is and what he came to do. Now the question is—Do you believe it?
