BIOGRAPHY

Major Doug Freidel enlisted into Company B, 153rd Engineer Battalion in 1976, while he was a freshman at Dakota State College in Madison, SD. He attended basic training at Ft. Knox, Kentucky and Advanced Individual Training at Ft. Benjamin Harrison, Indiana. Doug gained his commission to become an officer in the National Guard after attending the South Dakota Officer Candidate School in 1981.

After gaining his commission as an Engineer Officer, he held the position of Platoon Leader for Detachment 1, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 153rd Engineer Battalion. Major Freidel attended the Basic Officer Leadership Course at Ft. Belvoir, Virginia in the summer of 1983. Upon his return, he was assigned as the Executive Officer of Company D 153rd Engineer Battalion until 1985. He was then transferred to Company C, 153rd Engineer Battalion as their Company Commander until 1987. After his two year stint as Company Commander, he moved to the 153rd Engineer Battalion as an Assistant S3 and S1 until 1991. At that time, Major Freidel was transferred to 109th Engineer Group and became the Assistant S3 and S2 for two years. He finished his military career at the 340th Training Battalion as the S3 and XO and the 5th Training Brigades as the S3. Major Freidel retired with 22 years of service.

Major Freidel has been a Teacher, Coach, and High School Principal. He spent time as the Northeast Region Sales Manager for Daktronics and finished his working life owning restaurants and managing family dining facilities for Marlins Family Restaurants. He also was a high school boys and girls basketball official for 25 years.

He is currently retired in Corsica, SD and enjoys spending time with his 3 daughters and 6 grandchildren. Doug is an avid fisherman and hunter and loves spending time on the mighty MO. Please welcome Major Doug Freidel.
